<b>Objectives:</b>	To enrich students' design techniques / drawing skills
<b>Deliverables:</b>	Students' artworks and reflection
<b>Participants:</b> <b>(No./ Level)</b>	10-30 S4-S6 students nominated by Visual Arts Department
<b>Selection mechanism:</b>	Nomination
<b>Duration and start date:</b>	September 23 to August 2024
<b>Evaluation:</b>	Students were provided with more exposure in the design courses and drawing workshops. More than 80% of the participating students found the activities helpful in enhancing their learning.

<b>Title:</b>	Economic analytical skills enhancement workshop (School-based)
<b>Program/ Course Provider:</b>	an alumnus (Leung Kin Lok)
<b>Objectives:</b>	To enhance students' ability data literacy in analyzing social issues through an economic perspective;  To enhance students skills in essay writing
<b>Deliverables:</b>	Lessons
<b>Participants: (No./ Level)</b>	13  S.6 students
<b>Selection mechanism:</b>	S.6 students who were ranked top 30 % in Economics in 2022-2023
<b>Duration and start date:</b>	29/11/2023 - 29/2/2024
<b>Evaluation:</b>	There are 13 S6 students joining the programme for a total of 6 lessons. The average attendance rate is 73%. It was observed that the course helped students enhance their critical thinking skills in analyzing economic issues and improve their essay writing ability. However, since the S6 students were busy and had tight schedules, it is suggested to offer this program to S4 or S5 students.
